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## 1 Audacity håndbok

**Oversettelser** er del av pakken debian-edu-doc, som kan bli installert på en webtjener, og er tilgjengelig på nettet.

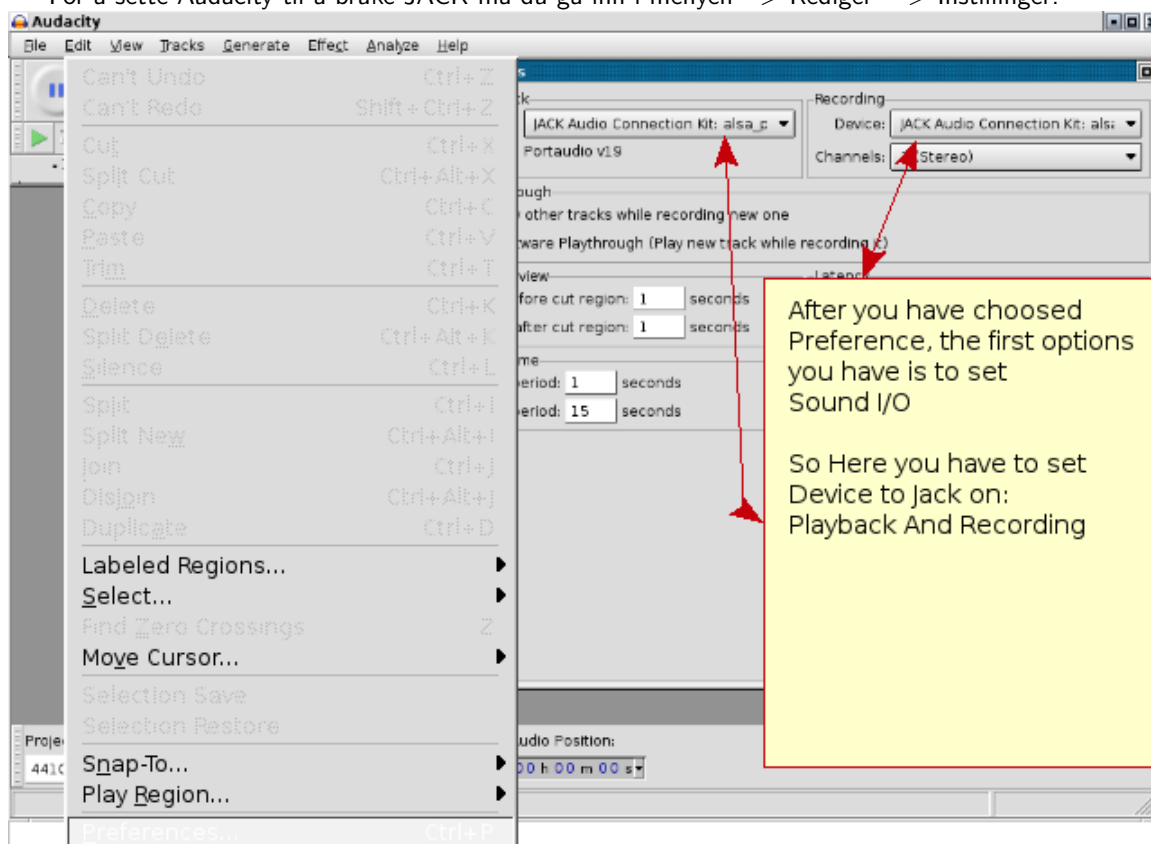
## 2 Før du starter

Å sette opp Audacity er ikke vanskelig hvis du husker å sette opp Audacity til å bruke JACK, for å gjøre det mulig for andre program å bruke lyd samtidig. Hvordan sette opp Jack til å virke sømløst? Oppskriften er her:

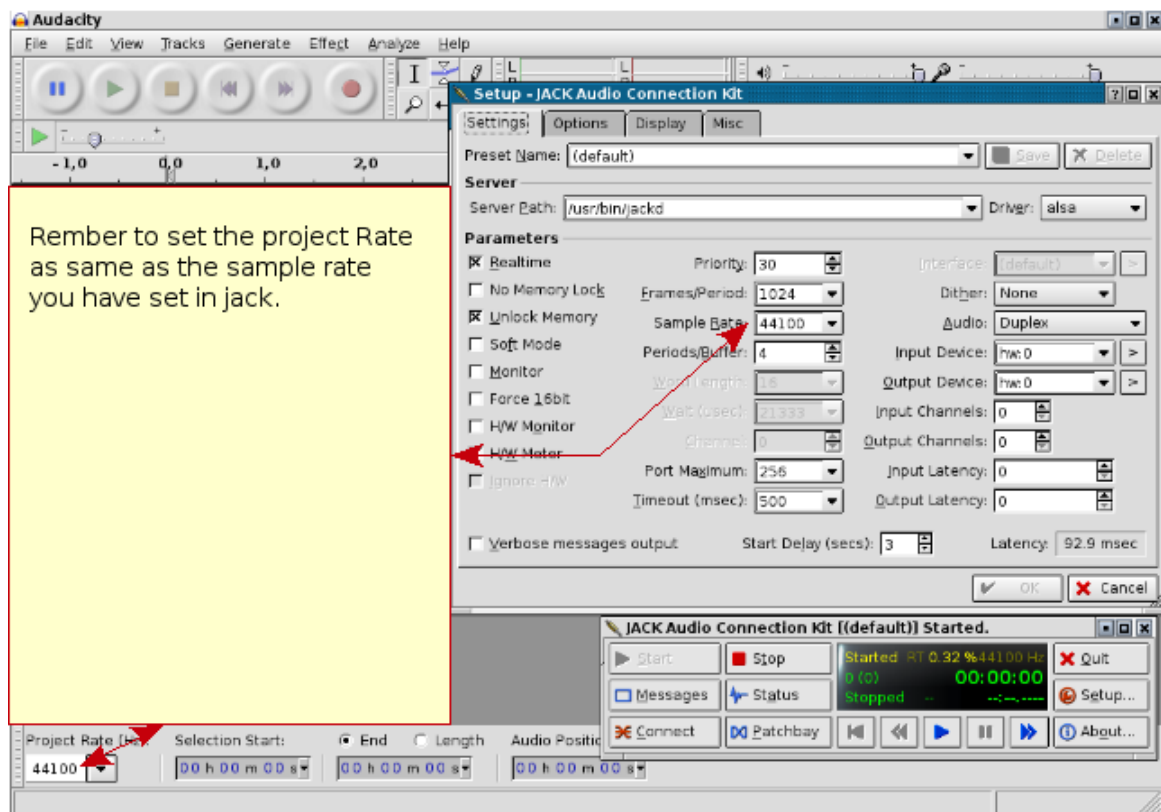

Jeg brukte Audacity 1.3.3-Beta da jeg lagde denne dokumentasjonen.

For å sette Audacity til å bruke JACK må du gå inn i menyen --> Rediger ---> Instillinger.



Det neste du må være klar over er at prosjektraten må være den samme som sampleringen (samplingsraten) du har satt i JACK.

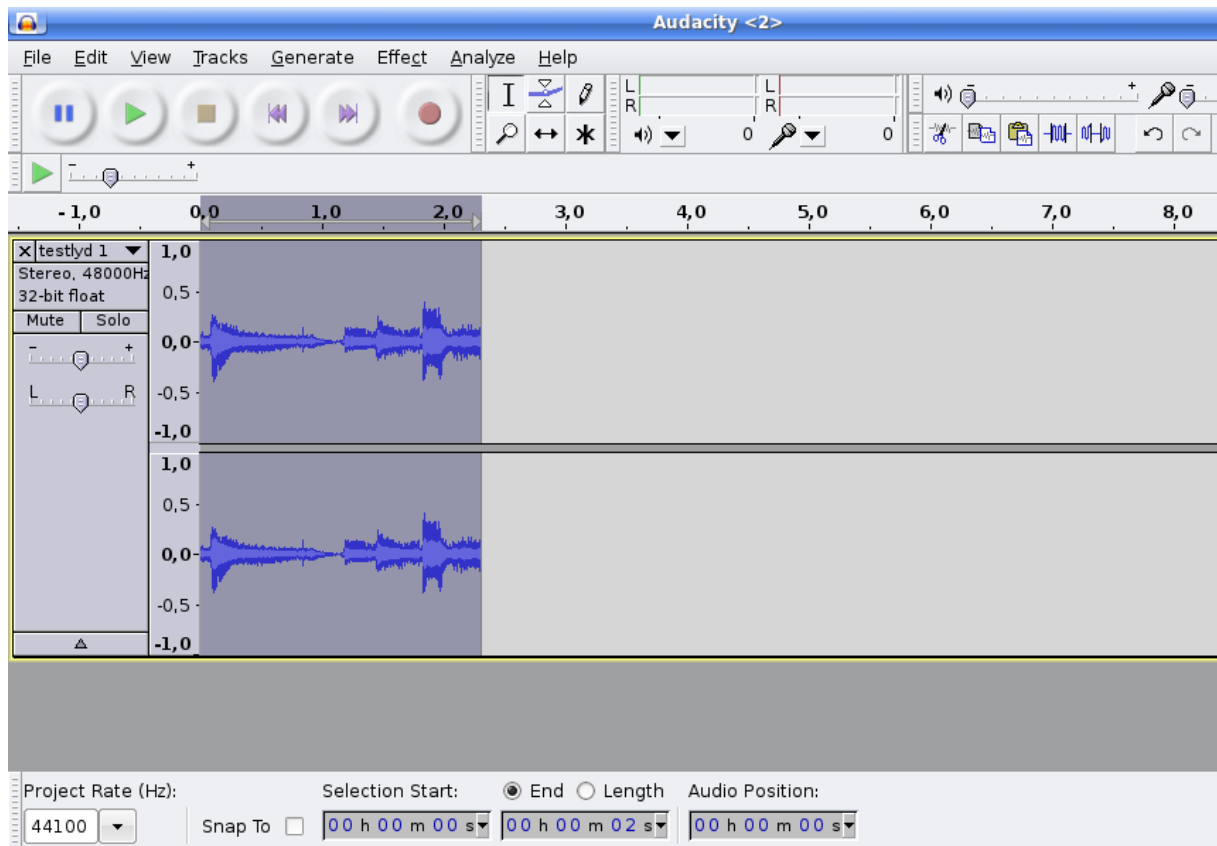

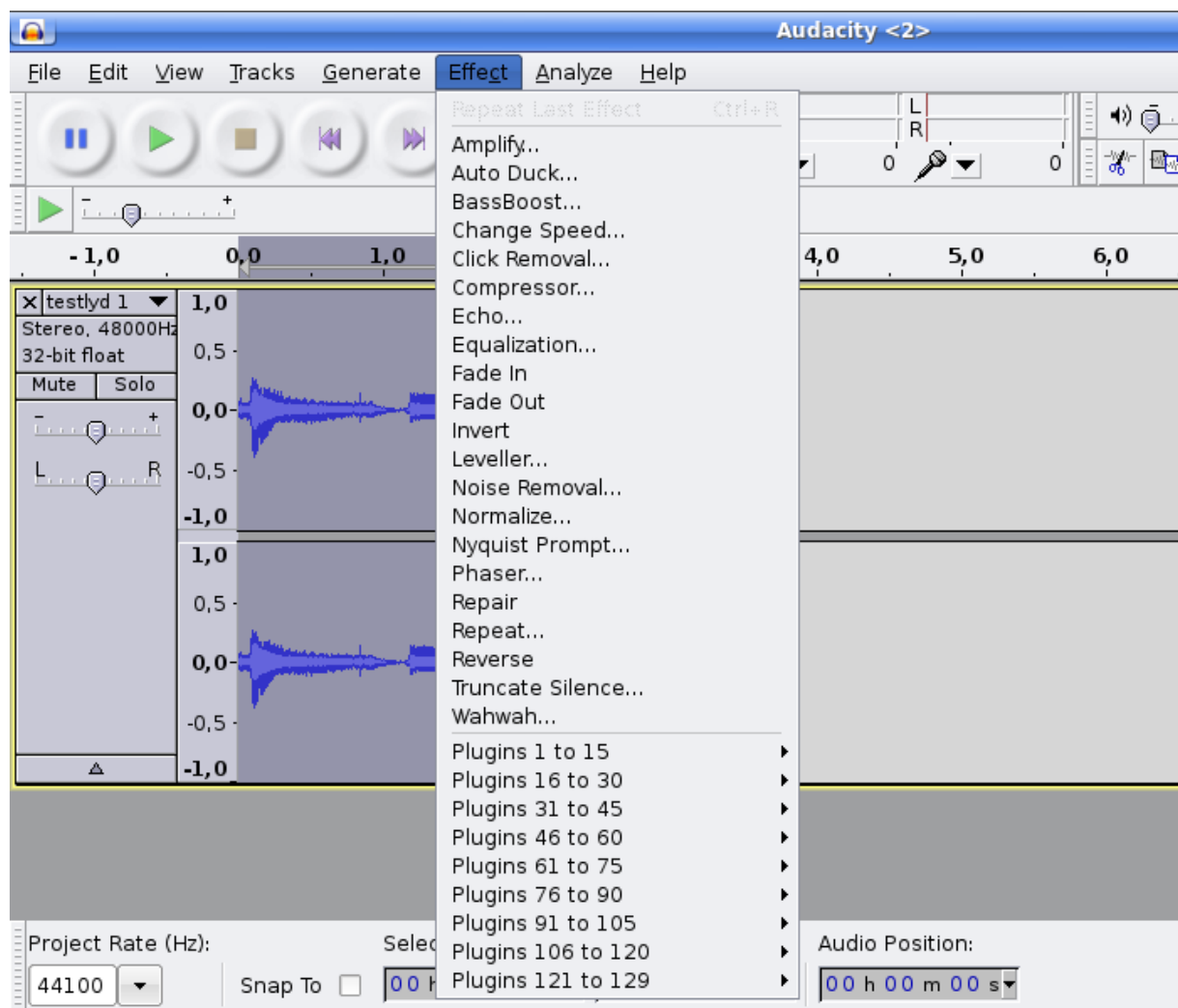
Du kan installere Audacity med aptitude, og du kan også se prosjektets hjemmeside <http://audacity.sourceforge.net/>

## 3 Å gjøre opptak

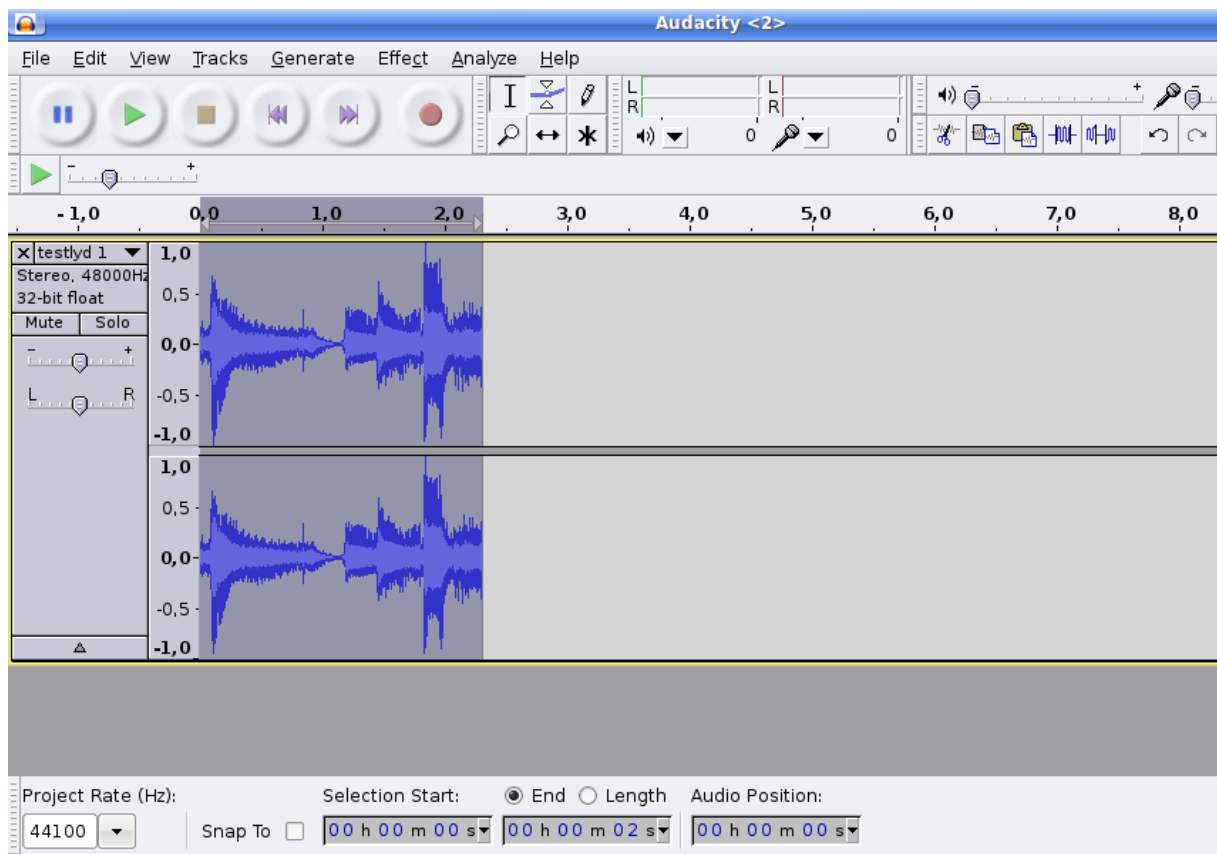
Det første du må huske når du gjør opptak, er at opptakets voluminstillinger ikke er satt for høyt. Det er bedre å ha volumet for lavt enn for høyt.



Når du har tatt opp det du ønsker, kan du normalisere opptaket slik at volumet blir korrekt uten fare for at lyden blir klippet.



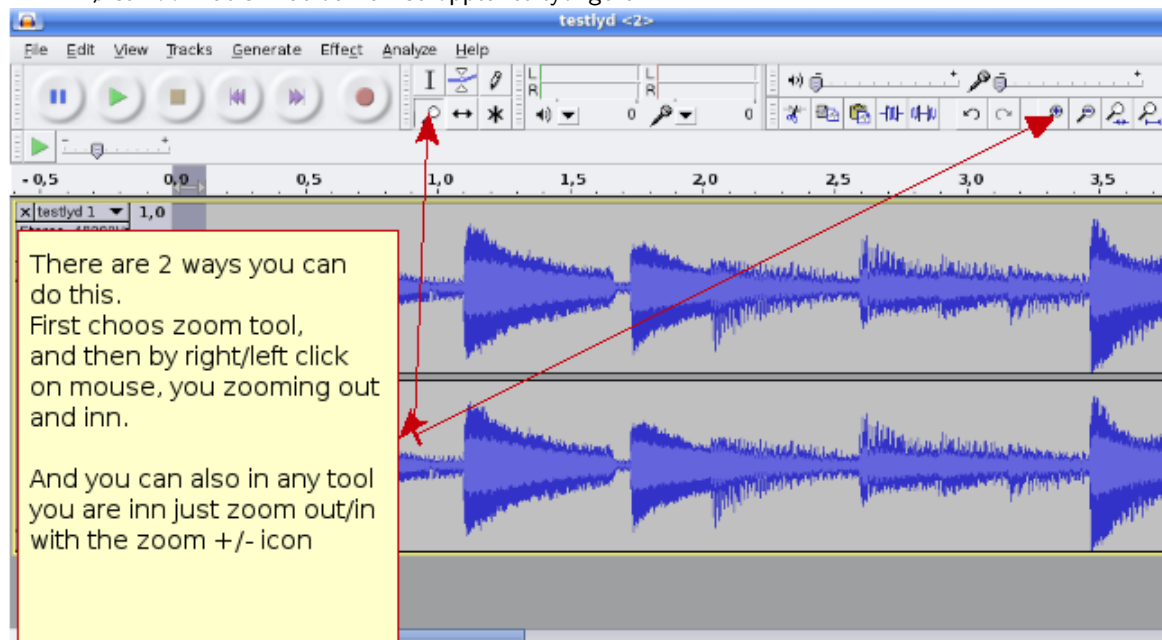
Etter du har normalisert opptaket, ser det slik ut:



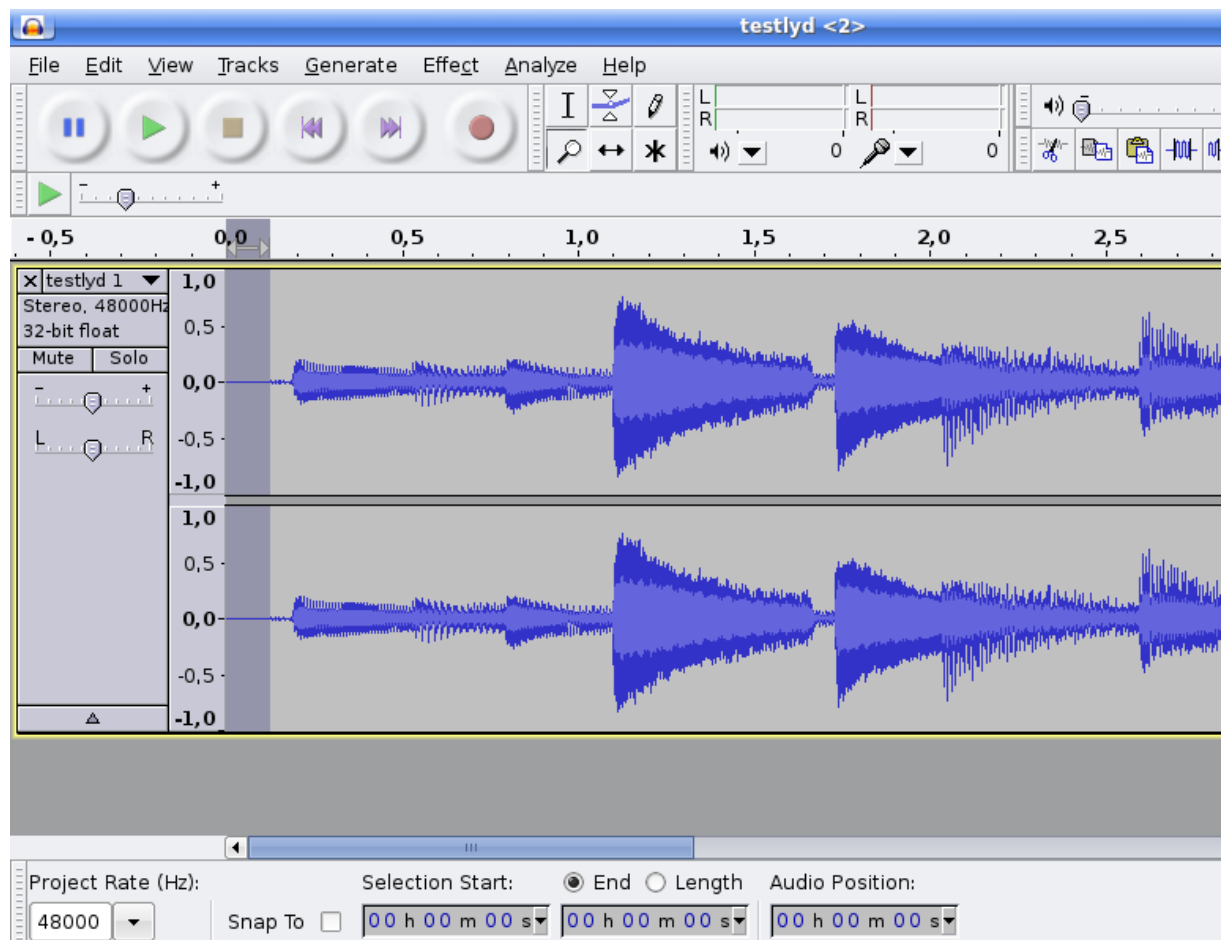
Nå er volumet på denne biten av opptaket korrekt. Dette er en bedre måte å passe på at opptaket du har gjort, ikke blir klippet.

Nå vil vi fjerne støy fra opptaket, for eksempel «bakgrunnsstøy» fra mikrofonen. Første steg er å lage en «støyprofil» av hva du vil fjerne fra opptaket.

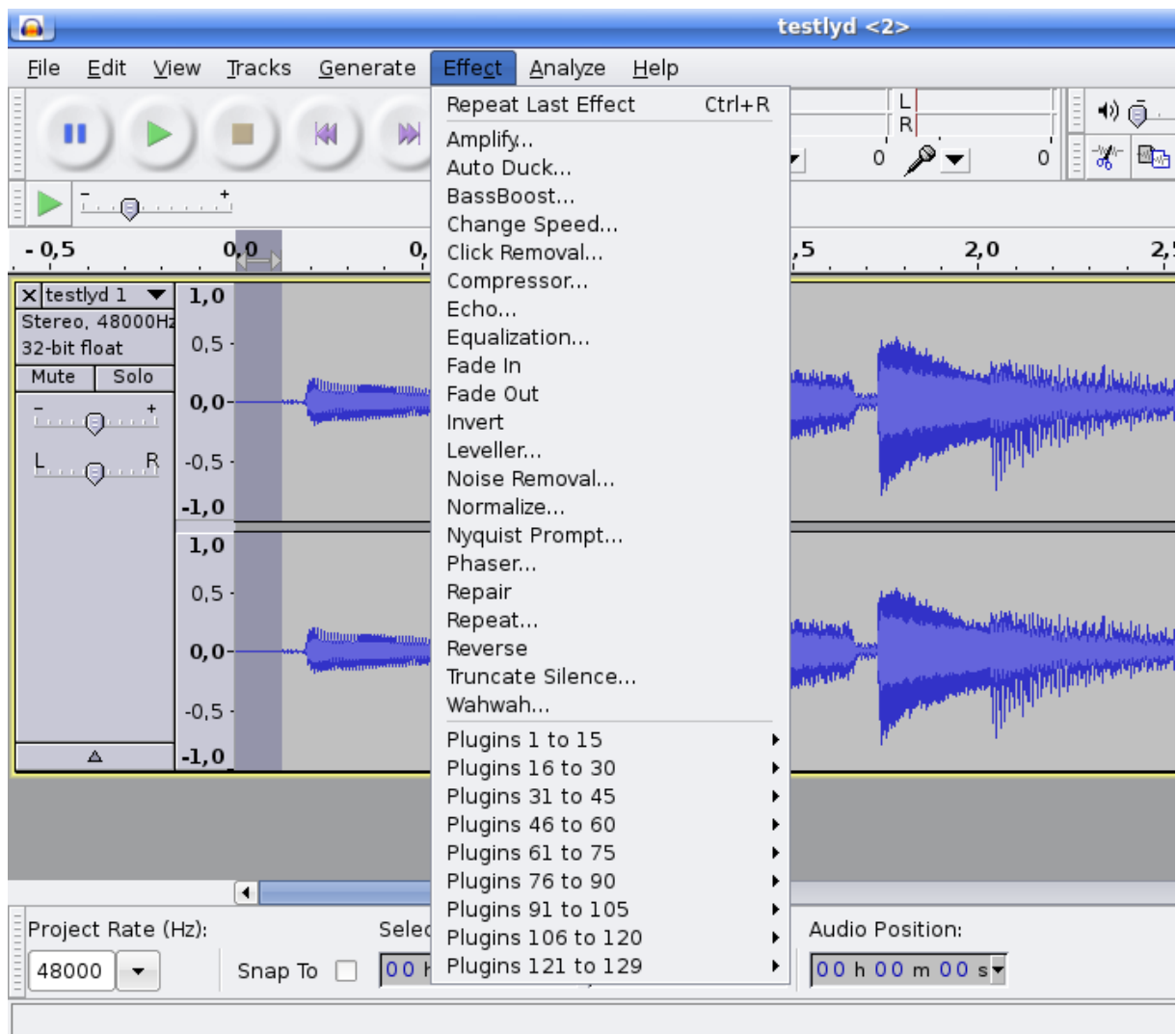
1. Først zoom ut slik at du kan se opptaket tydeligere.



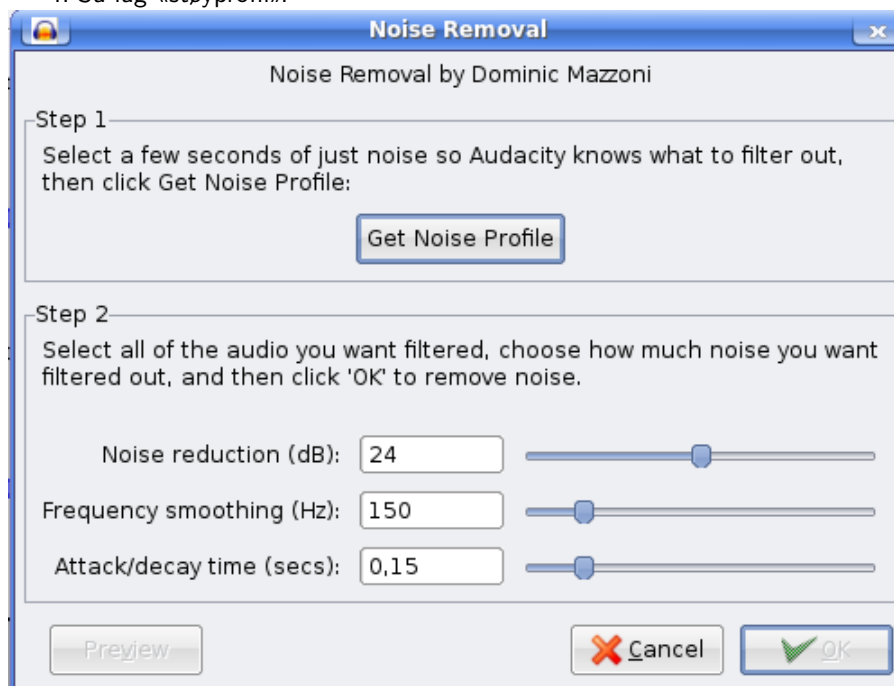
2. Deretter marker hva du vil lage en profil av. Klikk og hold ned venstre museknapp mens du drar. Marker området du trenger å få en profil av.



3. Deretter velg at du vil bruke Støyfjerning.



4. Så lag «støyprofil».



5. Velg så hele opptaket ved å klikke Ctrl + A, og velg Støyfjerning igjen fra menyen, men denne gangen trykk OK.

Hvis du ønsker å legge til gjenklang og andre effekter, så søker du bare i den store menyen som er tilgjengelig etter du installerte innstikkene som ble anbefalt.

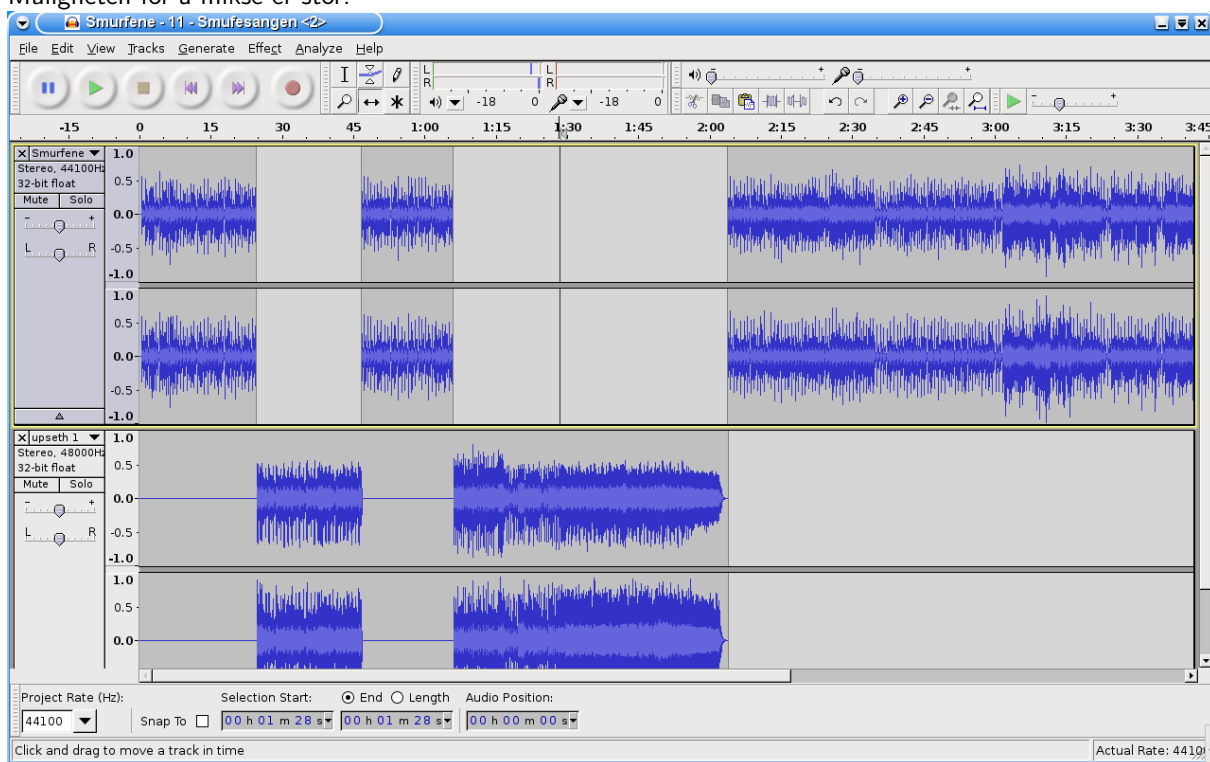
Du har flere måter å eksportere det ferdig resultatet på. Du kan eksportere som WAV, AIFF, MP3, Ogg, FLAC, bare velg Eksporter i Fil-menyen.

## 4 Importere lyd

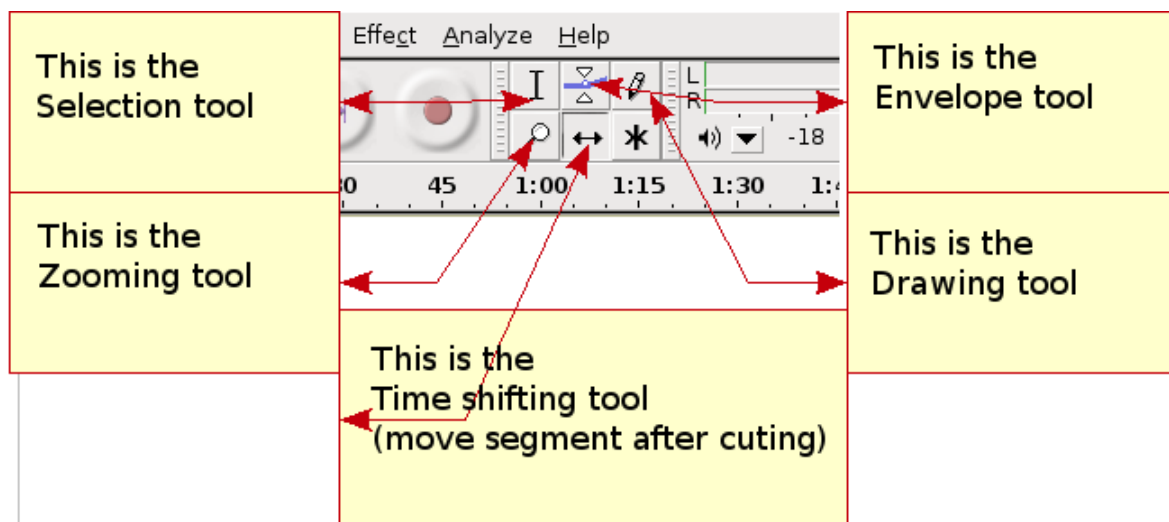
Med Audacity kan du importere lyd av typen Audio, Midi, Labels, og Raw Data. Du kan importere MP3-filer direkte inn i prosjektet, og mikse sammen forskjellige sanger i Audacity.

Her er et eksempel:

Først hovedsangen min «smurfesangen», og så kan du importere for miksing en sang til. Bare velg den i menyen > > Fil > > Importer Lyd, så vil det importerte lydsporet komme under det første lydsporet. Muligheten for å mikse er stor.

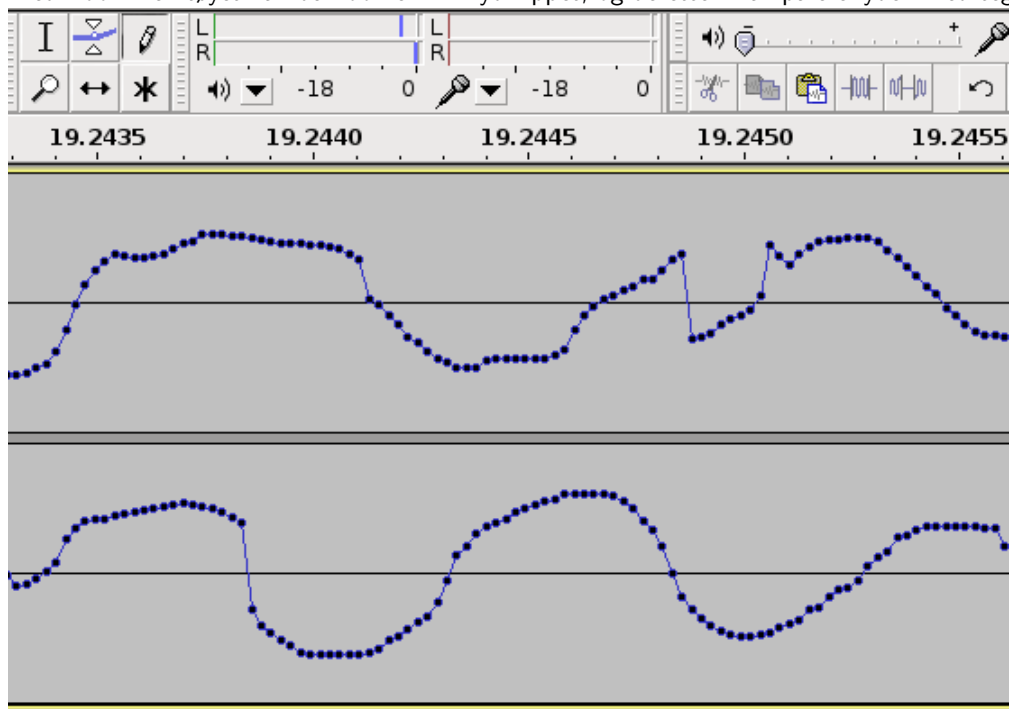


## 5.1 Utvalgsverktøy

For å splitte lyden slik at du kan flytte deler av den, må du først bruke utvalgsverktøyet, og velge hvor du vil kutte det. Bruk Ctrl + I for å splitte, og deretter kan du flytte delen med tidsskiftsverktøyet.

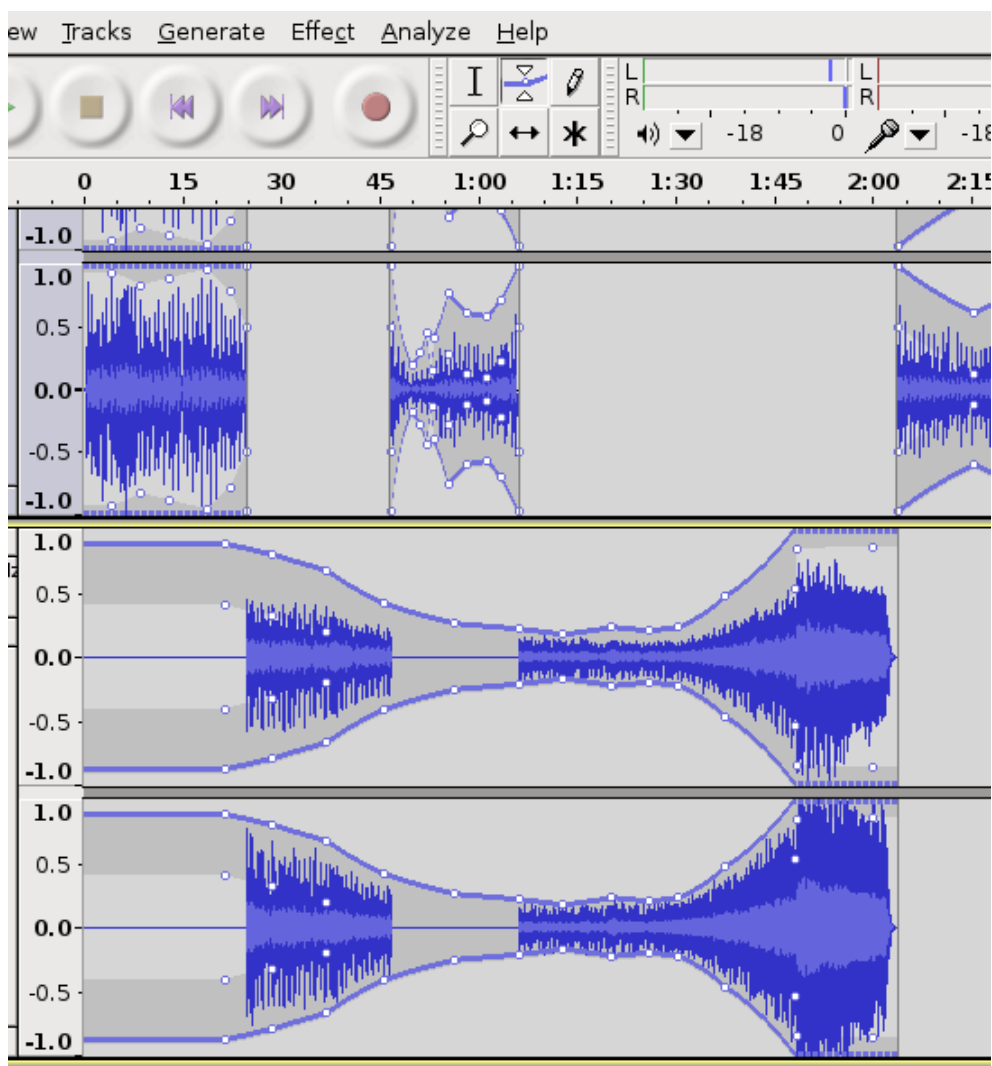
## 5.2 Zoom-verktøy

Med Zoom-verktøyet kan du zoome inn i lydklippet, og deretter manipulere lyden med tegneverktøyet.



## 5.3 Envelope-verktøy

Med Envelope-verktøyet kan du manipulere volumet ved å senke eller heve volumet hvor du er i klippet.



## 5.4 Tidsskiftsverktøy

Med dette kan du flytte lydklipp rundt.

Ta en titt om du ønsker hjelp i å oversette dette dokumentet.

For å bidra med oversettelser så må du være medlem av Alioth-prosjektet `debian-edu`. Om brukernavnet i Alioth er forskjellig fra det du har på datamaskinen du bruker, lag eller rediger filen `~/.ssh/config`. Den bør inneholde en linje som denne:

```

Sjekk kilden `debian-edu-doc` med å bruke SSH-tilgang: `git clone git+ssh://git.debian.org/git/debian-edu/debian-edu-doc.git`

Hvis du bare ønsker å oversette, trenger du bare å sjekke ut noen filer fra Git (som kan gjøres anonymt) og lage patcher. Send inn en feilrapport mot `debian-edu-doc`, og legg ved PO-filen til [feilrapporten](#). Du kan finne noen [instruksjoner om hvordan du sender bugs](#) her.

Du kan hente ut kilden for `debian-edu-doc` anonymt med denne kommandoen (du må ha pakken `git` installert for at dette skal fungere):

- `git clone git://anonscm.debian.org/debian-edu/debian-edu-doc.git`

Så redigerer du `documentation/audacity/audacity-manual.$CC.po` (der du bytter ut `$CC` med språkkoden din). Det er mange verktøy tilgjengelig for å oversette, vi foreslår at du bruker `lokalize`.

Så kan du enten melde filen inn direkte til SVN (hvis du har rettigheter til det), eller sende filen til e-postlisten. (Deretter kan du enten melde filen direkte til Git (hvis du har rettighetene til å gjøre det), eller sende filen til feilrapport (bugreport).)

For å oppdatere din lokale kopi av arkivet kan du bruke denne kommandoen inne i mappen `debian-edu-doc`:

- `git pull`

Les `/usr/share/doc/debian-edu-doc/README.audacity-manual-translation` for å finne informasjon om hvordan lage en ny PO-fil for ditt språk hvis det ikke finnes allerede, og hvordan oppdatere oversettelser.

Vær spesielt oppmerksom på at denne håndboken fortsatt er under utvikling, så ikke oversett noen tekst (tekststreng) som inneholder "FIXME".
